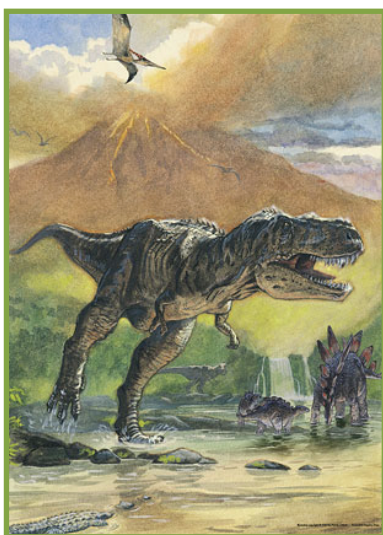
## Of Fossils and Faith: Reflections of a Dinosaur Paleontologist

“Dinosaurs are just as much a part of Creation as the most elegant animals that are alive today. God loved dinosaurs! They were jewels of Creation. We know this because there were so many of them and they lived for so long!” Hear Dr. Dodson explain, as a paleontologist and evolutionary biologist, why he studies dinosaurs and the laws by which he believes the Creator has worked over billions of years.

**Dr. Peter Dodson** holds three degrees in earth sciences: a B.S. from the University of Ottawa, a Masters from the University of Alberta and a Ph.D. from Yale University. He has spent his entire career as a gross anatomist at the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine, and as a dinosaur paleontologist in the Department of Earth and Environmental Science at the University of Pennsylvania. He is currently working on a book about the dinosaurs of China.
